## Loving Hands Charity Home est. March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2009:



At present 19 kids (13 Girls and 6 boys) we have. We are sending them to a nearby government school which is a half a kilometer away.

It was all G-D's guidance other wise would have not started then. In the beginning the home was having the building, bore well and a power connection. But as now and when we started G-D provided one after other all what are needed.

Since last ten months we are providing to each boy / girl three pairs of dresses, inner ware, brushes, soaps, oils, medicines of all kinds, Books and stationary, sandals, bags, blankets, towels, mats and etc...Shortly we are going to provide smooth mattresses. We waited till now as some are wetting the mats in the nights. Food of many qualities, three times a day according to menu which includes boiled rice, cooked rice, upma, idly, pulihora, dall, fresh vegetables, chicken, eggs, milk, sweets and different bakery items. As you know the local pastor is the faithful in-charge / warden. We are providing him a bi-cycle, a cell phone, a fixed salary and as and when he can eat. Meeting all his sudden needs. Providing complete new dresses to whole his family once a year. Every thing is at his disposal.

Also we have a lady cook who cooks three times a day, washes and keeps the kitchen clean. Weekly once the kids washes their things for which we supply sufficient detergent. All rooms are provided with fans and ventilation.

The Villagers way of living is very peculiar. They leave all the rules aside for their benefit and behaves very mean. Due to this we faced many rough situations but only G-D who is at our side helped in all such situations. During different activities in schools our kids stood very meritoriously. Though local kids some times created ugly scenes to our kids in school we came over all those successfully by HIS grace.

Besides all these ups and downs G-D is being glorified as our kids are learning the songs, hymns, choruses, word of G-D , culture and Christian discipline. This will surely bring good change in their homes, villages and in school too. This is the hope and satisfaction which is leading the Indian team.
